


Instructions of Use Stand Assist Sling






Sling Application:




Open waist support and place the sling around the back of the patient.



Take the patient's arms and place them over the sling.




Fasten the hook & loop waist support around the patient's waist (for women this should be just under the bust).




Take each cord from the standaid through the loop on either side of the sling.


Sling Application Continued:




Ensure each cord is threaded through the loop on either side of the sling.



Secure the cord firmly within the 'cup'.



When both cords are attached correctly make adjustments on both cords equally so that any slack is taken up in each cord and the back section of the sling supports the patient comfortably and securely, lock the adjustment cords down into the cord 'cup.'



Always check that the sling adjustment cords are fully in position and locked before and during the commencement of the lifting cycle, and in tension as the patient's weight is gradually taken up.



Important:

The Stand Assist Sling is designed for a general purpose transfer for patients with weight bearing ability. From seated to standing positions.

The patient must be assessed by a competent person who is fully trained in the suitability, application and fitting of the sling. Carers should always be trained in the use of hoists and slings.

Correct sizing of a sling is important, if in any doubt consult your Moving and Handling Advisor.

Service Label & Sling Checks:

All products should be checked each time they are used for any signs of deterioration.

Please Check:

- braiding/tapes for deterioration and fraying
- material for holes/snagging
- compatibility with the hoist
- safe working load of both the hoist and sling/product (if applicable)
- label is legible

Remove from use immediately if there are any signs of deterioration to the sling or tapes or the label is illegible. The Service Label is a visual indicator of when the 6-monthly or annual hoist inspection has been completed. This is in line with LOLER (Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations).

Warranty:

Silvalea offers a 12 month manufacturers warranty on all products unless otherwise stated. Scan QR Code or visit our website downloads page for more information.

Washing Guidelines:

- Follow laundry temperatures for washing and drying detailed on the product label.
- Always ensure that all Hook & Loop fastenings are fully closed before washing.
- All products should be laundered using nonbiological detergents.
- Metal fixings are sometimes used in our products. Care should be taken to ensure that all products containing metal attachments are washed in a pillowcase or wash bag to prevent damage to the product or to washing equipment. Silvalea accept no liability for damage to laundry equipment.
- DO NOT IRON
- Always remove the head support bones prior to washing to prevent damage to the sling & bones
- Silva-Superfine with COOLMAX® mesh slings are provided with a wash bag. The wash bag MUST be used during laundering.

Product Care:

- Ensure that any Hook & Loop fastenings are closed when not in use. This will prevent unnecessary snagging of the sling material and prevent clogging of the Hook & Loop.
- · Launder regularly.
- Store products in a suitable dry clean place.
- Silvalea will accept no liability for any additions/ adaptations made to our products that have NOT been carried out by ourselves. Doing so may cause serious injury or death to the user.

Drying Guidelines:

- Follow the recommended drying temperatures as stated on product label.
- Overheating a textile product can cause deterioration in the material components.
- Do not place the product on a convector heater or steam pipes.
